Bids for the above referenced project were received on June 18, 2019. Seven (7) contractors picked up bid documents and one (1) contractor submitted a proposal with a base bid of \$363,975.00 with alternates A-1 thru A-4 in the amount of bid of \$180,800.00, as shown on the attached tabulation of bids.

The references for the low bidder, Precise Construction, Incorporated, Freehold, NJ, have been checked by this office and found to satisfactory. Our office has also administered several projects with this contractor.

We, therefore, recommend that a contract is awarded to Precise Construction, Incorporated, Freehold, NJ for the base bid, in the amount of \$363,975.00 with the approval of alternate items A-1 & A-2 in the amount of \$135,500.00, for a total project cost of **\$499,475.00** subject to NJDEP review and available funding. The low bid was within the engineering estimate for this project.
